Welcome

We call it 360 because the Leadership Day is six hours long or three hundred and sixty minutes of inspiration, training, and meaningful fellowship. It is a one day conference designed to equip and inspire everyone who serves in the local church from a new volunteer to a full time pastor.

This year the theme for Western Pennsylvania Ministries of the Church of God is *Life Right Side Up*. In Matthew 6:10 (NIV) it says, "Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.." This year we are asking ourselves how to be a citizen in the Kingdom of God. By looking at the Sermon on the Mount we find out what Kingdom Living is. It is different than what we naturally think, it looks like living out the Sermon on Mount.

This is exactly what 360 hopes to accomplish. A day for us to gather and be challenged in our mindset and ministry.

This year our special focus as we look at *Life Right Side Up* is how we flesh out the Kingdom principles taught by Jesus while we are here on earth. We can be overwhelmed with the state of society and the pace at which everything is changing, but our call has remained the same. In light of this we wanted to try something different. We have created a schedule where all of the breakouts are offered more than once so that you can mix and match tracks of information to best help you accomplish this mission.

After the opening session of worship and instruction we will be going into different breakouts to focus on several areas of ministry including Kingdom Living, Mental Health, Church Budgeting, Disciple Making, and Spiritual Life. With 10 different breakouts offered over 4 sessions there is something for everyone. Simply choose a track or mix and match breakouts from different tracks that meet your needs and inform your passion. Breakouts

ingdom Living track

This track will be looking at shifts we have to embrace to live out the kingdom

M ental Health track

This track will be looking at how the church can respond and help bring healing to people experiencing a mental health crisis.

- Triaging, Recognizing and Responding (1 and 2) Quick overview of Mental Health issues and how to interact. Presenter Water's Edge Christian Services Meadville, PA
- Walking Alongside a Family (3 and 4) Caring for a family in crisis. Presenters Sherri Fields Robertsdale, PA and Rebecca New-Edson State Director



C hurch Budgeting track

This track will be looking at how the church can be a good steward of the resources they have been given. Presenter Nabil Safi.

- 1. **Church Budgeting** (1 and 3) How to be faithful in laying out a plan for finances in the church.
- 2. **Staff Compensation** (2 and 4) How to fairly set a payment package for staff.

iscipleship track

This track will be looking at the ways people in the Bible developed the leaders beside them. Presenter Brandon Lenhart Lead Pastor of North Main Street Church of God Butler, PA.

- 1. **Red Letters Jesus' Approach** (1 and 3) The importance of teams and not doing ministry alone.
- 2. **Beyond the Red Letters Paul and Barnabas** (2 and 4) Training people alongside while doing ministry together.

S piritual Life track

This track will be looking at taking care of your personal spiritual development

- 1. **Experiential Prayer** (1 and 2) Learning about hearing God and engaging in conversation with Him. Presenter Crystal Epps Pastor of First Church of God New Castle, PA.
- 2. **Burnout Prevention** (3 and 4) What causes it and proactive habits to prevent it Presenter Bob Shallenberger Lead Pastor of North Apollo Church of God.

What is the Cost?

This training is being brought to you by Western Pennsylvania Church of God ministries at a low cost to help you get the best for your ministry. *The cost is \$35 a person* and includes not only the training but also your lunch.
