IF YOU HAVE NOT RENEWED YOUR BACKGROUND CHECKS and Mandated Reporter Training, it is time to update them. Pennsylvania State law requires that they be renewed every 60 months. Those in violation may need to meet with the Credentialing Services Committee.




CAROLYN MEADOWS, mother of Carolyn Wolford, moved into the full presence of the Lord, February 13, 2022. Pray for her family.
